The main drawbacks of the app are the lack of advanced features and the fact that you cannot modify the current user details. Furthermore, you cannot export or import the stored information. In addition, the application does not offer any security measures for its users. Even though it offers a two-factor authentication mode, this is not secure, as you can still rely on the application's features. PasswordManager has a very simple interface that is easy to use, however, it is quite limited. No, PasswordManager does not really contain your passwords. It is, as the name implies, a password manager, which means that it should manage your passwords. It just happens that they are stored in a very insecure way, so this is probably the least of your concerns. If you like, however, you can add passwords to PasswordManager or use it to find them. The main functionality of the application, however, is to search through all your entries stored on the device. While PasswordManager does offer a search feature, it is highly unlikely to be able to display all the data that you have stored. In addition, the program does not store all your passwords in a single place, but rather in different locations, which is why you can not use the search option to find them. When you want to find a password, you have two options: click on the "Find" button, or use the search field in the main window. The former option will take you to a screen where you can use the various criteria available to find the relevant entry. The search function itself is not the best, as it doesn't search for all the available data and is therefore not comprehensive, and it is also very slow. The main problem with PasswordManager, however, is that it is extremely disorganized. When you search for a certain entry, the program will display the names and passwords of all the entries that contain this specific information. However, you will not see the names and passwords of all the entries in a single group, which makes it extremely difficult to find what you are looking for. Completely designed, but works only with a small number of accounts PasswordManager is a simple program that does not offer a lot of features. You can add new entries and change existing ones, but that is it. The program is designed to store your data and allow you to find it, but offers no functionality beyond this. Furthermore, the only available option is to add information to the database. While it is possible to browse the database after you have added all the relevant data, there is no way to sort the entries based on their parameters or view them in a table. In addition, password management is not the best way to go. You cannot manage your passwords in any other way than by adding new entries. All your passwords are stored in an unprotected TXT file, and in order to access this document, you must use the application itself, which means that it will not work with any other programs

The application stores your password in a "passwords.txt" file. You can add as many passwords as you like. You can search passwords, sort passwords by username.
